


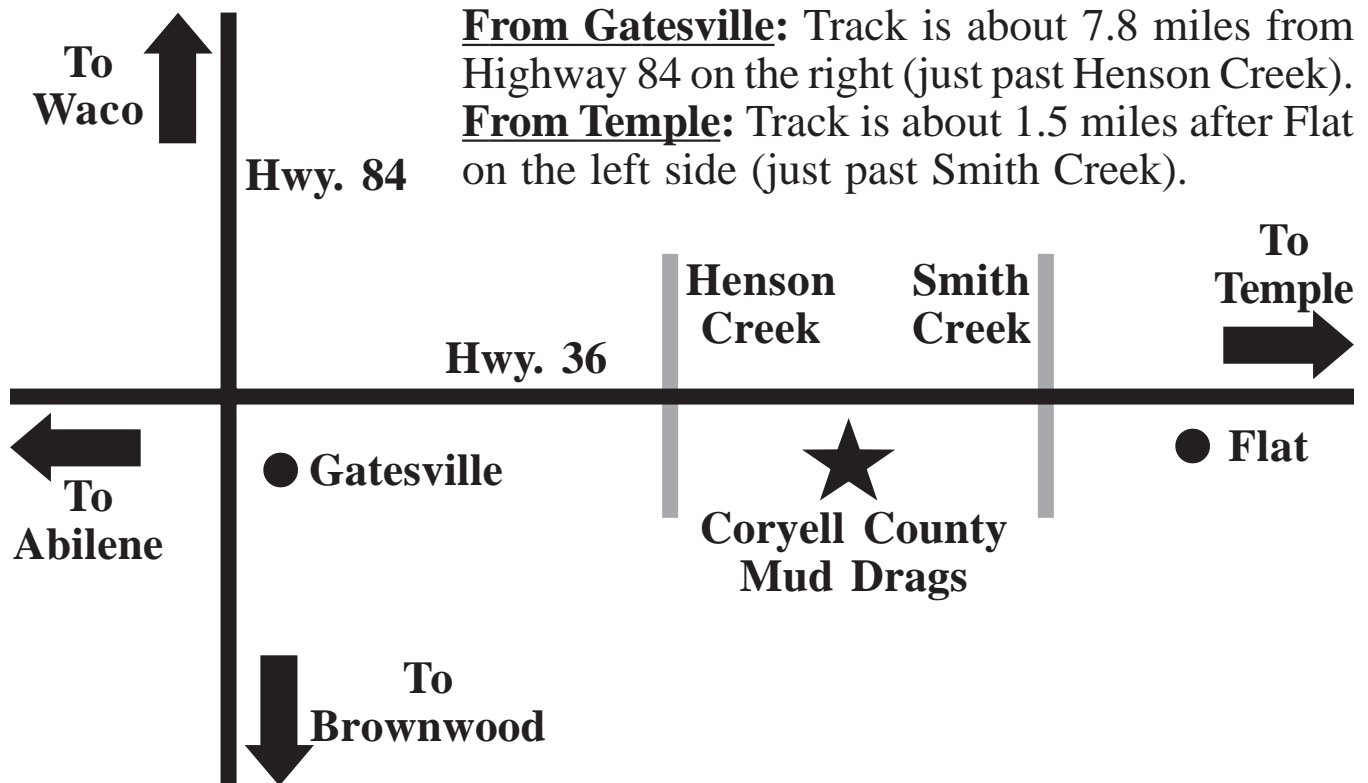

From Gatesville: Track is about 7.8 miles from Highway 84 on the right (just past Henson Creek).

From Temple: Track is about 1.5 miles after Flat on the left side (just past Smith Creek).

Admission & Entry Fees

Pit Side

Truck & Driver: \$35.00

Pit Pass: \$10.00

(Under 14 not allowed in pits except during intermission.)

Spectator Side

Adult: \$8.00

Children Under 12: \$6.00

Pay Out

Based on 10 trucks per class.

(Less than 10 trucks--75% of purse.)

Class 2

Class 3

Coryell County Mud Drags

General Rules

1. A vehicle may be allowed to run in more than one class, however, the vehicle may be allowed to run classes higher than the primary class it is permanently registered for. If at a later date a driver wishes to run just one class; he must run the class he permanently registered for. (See * next page.)
2. Only the driver & co-pilot will be permitted to ride in the vehicle during the race, both must sign a liability release.
3. Entry fee for driver and truck will be \$35.00 for all classes. Pit crew and all other persons entering pit area will pay \$10.00 pit admission fee. Any person entering the pit must sign a liability release. No refunds under any circumstance.
4. No alcoholic beverages allowed in the pit area. Persons caught consuming alcohol in the pit area will be escorted off the property.
5. Registration for all vehicles will be from 12:00 p.m. to 1:30 p.m. Vehicles not weighed in by 1:30 p.m. will be placed last in race order.
6. Races start at 2:00 p.m.
7. There will be a three minute time limit for the vehicle to approach the starting line after their name/number has been called. If unable to stage in time you will be disqualified.
8. Once your vehicles is staged and the stage light comes on, you cannot back up and restage. For safety reasons, rules will be enforced.
9. Every vehicle must have good operating brakes.
10. All weights must be securely fastened to vehicle. If any weight is lost during the race you will be disqualified.
11. You must have a fully charged fire extinguisher in vehicle.
12. You must have a 5 point safety harness for all classes except stock which must have at least the factory seatbelt with shoulder belt.
13. Open wheel base vehicles are recommended to use arm restraints.
14. All participants must wear helmets.

15. Any vehicle going out of bounds will be disqualified. The judges' decision will be final.
16. No driver or co-pilot will be allowed to consume alcohol at any either time prior to, or during the races. Anyone found violating this rule will lead to the disqualification of the team.
17. Judges will check to be sure that all vehicles meet the requirements of their class; including general safety requirements.
18. Everyone in the pit area must have a pit pass and sign a liability waiver. No one under the age of 14 is allowed in the pit area after the races start.
19. Roll bar and drive shaft loops are required on all classes except stock.
20. Drivers suit required for all classes except stock.
21. ATTENTION: All drivers *must* start deceleration immediately at the finish line. In the attempt to clean the tires: *you must* come to a complete stop then burp throttle, and then you may proceed into the pit area. Continuing to accelerate through the shutdown area will not be tolerated. First offense will result in a *warning*. Second offense will result in a possible *disqualification* of the run prior to the offense. This rule is for everyone's safety and will be *strictly enforced*!
22. Absolutely no excessive acceleration at any time in the pit area. **Idle speed only!**

Coryell County Mud Drags

Class 1 Rules

(Pro--Special Events Only)

1. Any body style having a professional appearance permitted.
2. Must have a properly secured roll-cage constructed of 1¼" round tubing.
3. Must have two properly secured driveshaft loops on each drive shaft.
4. Must have a properly functioning brake system to adequately stop the vehicle within 200 feet.
5. Transmission blanket or shield is required.
6. Any type of suspension permitted.
 - a. Ladder Bar
 - b. Four-Link
7. Any gear ratio combination permitted.
8. Any D.O.T. cut tire with maximum height of 44" permitted. Paddle tires allowed.
9. Gasoline or alcohol permitted. Fuel additives permitted.
10. Any engine size or combination permitted.
 - a. Sfi approved damper and flywheel required.
 - b. Tunnel ram single or dual carburetor permitted.
 - c. All non-electric fuel injections permitted.
 - d. Blowers permitted.
 - e. Nitrous oxide permitted on naturally aspirated engines only.
11. Total vehicle weight including driver must exceed 2,500 lbs. for both big and small blocks.

Coryell County Mud Drags

Class 2 Rules

(Open)

1. Any body style having a professional appearance permitted. Trimming and narrowing of body allowed.
2. Must have a properly secured roll-cage constructed of 1¼" round tubing.
3. Must have two properly secured driveshaft loops on each drive shaft.
4. Must have a properly functioning brake system to adequately stop the vehicle within 200 feet.
5. Transmission blanket or shield is required.
6. Any type of suspension permitted.
 - a. Ladder Bar
 - b. Four-Link
7. Any gear ratio combination permitted.
8. Any D.O.T. cut tire with maximum height of 44" permitted. No paddle tires allowed.
9. Gasoline or alcohol permitted. No additives.
10. Any engine size or combination permitted.
 - a. Sfi approved damper and flywheel required.
 - b. Tunnel ram single or dual carburetor permitted.
 - c. All non-electric fuel injections permitted.
 - d. No blowers permitted.
 - e. Nitrous oxide permitted.
11. Total vehicle weight including driver must exceed 2,800 lbs.

All General Rules Apply.

Coryell County Mud Drags

Class 3 Rules

(Modified)

1. Any body style having a professional appearance permitted. Trimming and narrowing of body allowed. No tube frames.
2. Must have a properly secured roll-cage constructed of 1¼" round tubing.
3. Must have two properly secured driveshaft loops on each drive shaft.
4. Must have a properly functioning brake system to adequately stop the vehicle within 200 feet.
5. Transmission blanket or shield is required.
6. Any type of suspension permitted.
 - a. Ladder Bar
 - b. Four-Link
7. Any gear ratio combination permitted.
8. Any D.O.T. cut tire with maximum height of 44" permitted. No paddle tires allowed.
9. Gasoline only.
10. Any small or big block under 500 cubic inches permitted.
 - a. Sfi approved damper and flywheel recommended.
 - b. No aluminum heads.
 - c. Only one carburetor of any size permitted.
11. Total vehicle weight including driver must exceed
 - a. 3,200 lbs. for big blocks.
 - a. 3,000 lbs. for small blocks.

Coryell County Mud Drags

Class 4 Rules

(Super Stock)

1. Factory body style permitted.
 - a. Must be a full body truck.
 - b. Trimming permitted for tire clearance only.
 - c. No narrowing allowed.
 - d. Bed must be enclosed.
2. Must have a properly secured roll-cage constructed of 1¼" round tubing.
3. Must have two properly secured driveshaft loops on each drive shaft.
4. Must have a properly functioning brake system to adequately stop the vehicle within 200 feet.
5. Transmission blanket or shield is required.
6. Stock suspension only. May have traction bars.
7. Any gear ratio combination permitted.
8. Any D.O.T. uncut tire with maximum height of 44" permitted. Uncut tires only.
9. Gasoline only.
10. Any small or big block under 472 cubic inches permitted.
 - a. Sfi approved damper and flywheel recommended.
 - b. No aluminum heads.
 - c. Only one carburetor of any size permitted.
11. Total vehicle weight including driver must exceed
 - a. 4,500 lbs. for big blocks.
 - a. 4,300 lbs. for small blocks.

Coryell County Mud Drags

Class 5 Rules

(Stock)

1. Stock frame and body only.
 - a. Must retain all factory interior and exterior panels.
 - b. Any type bed allowed.
 - c. No frame modifications.
 - d. Must be street able with windshield.
 - e. Current safety inspection and license required.
 - f. No ATV type vehicles or motorcycles.
2. Must have a properly functioning brake system to adequately stop the vehicle within 200 feet.
3. Stock suspension only. May have traction bars.
4. Any gear ratio combination permitted.
5. Uncut D.O.T. tires only.
6. Seatbelts with shoulder straps required.
7. Fire extinguisher required.
8. All occupants must wear a helmet.
9. Gasoline only. No nitrous oxide or additives.
10. Factory transmission only.
11. Stock O.E.M. engine must have been available in model of vehicle.
 - a. No open headers.
 - b. 750 cfm maximum carburetor.
 - c. Aftermarket intake allowed.
 - d. Must draw at least 15" of vacuum at idle.

All General Rules Apply.
